

The Falconer Organization Chart



Editor-in-Chief

Edits all articles, manages all editorial decisions, newspaper design, editors, and club personnel.



Advisor

Responsible for all students enrolled in a class, and is the liaison between FCPS and *The Falconer*.

SENIOR EDITORS

(In dashed line)



Executive Editor

Leadership but non-editorial role. Advised on decisions but ultimately considered outside of the chain of command.



Managing Editor

Edits all articles and designs all newspaper pages. Highest-ranking member after editor-in-chief.



Section Editors

Responsible for editing articles in their assigned section and designing their section's newspaper pages.

Editorial Board

All members to the left of the red line make up the editorial board.

Not Included:
Individuals such as any FCPS staff member other than the advisor (principal, superintendent, etc) are not a part of the chain of command and have no authority whatsoever. See *The Falconer Guidebook* for more information about conflicts with FCPS.

(To editors for all editorial, promotion decisions, and club students. To advisor for all students enrolled in a course).
